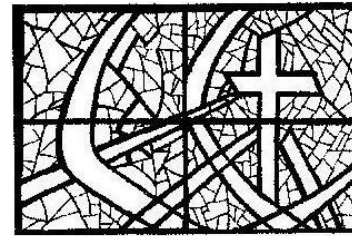

A New Law, the GDPR (The General Data Protection Regulation), which relates to the data we hold about you – mainly your address & other contact details – comes into force at the end of May. It will give

you more rights & control over how this information can be used. In the next few weeks, we'll be asking every church member to complete a form to confirm the ways in which you are happy for us to use this information, e.g. to contact you about Church Services & events. **EVERYONE needs to fill one in if they want the church to keep in touch with them.** Please place your completed forms in the box provided at the back of Church.
